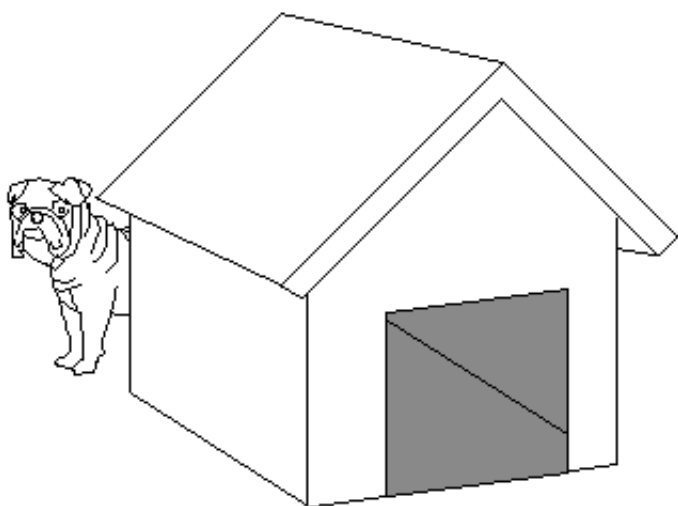
The dog is out of the doghouse.

next to



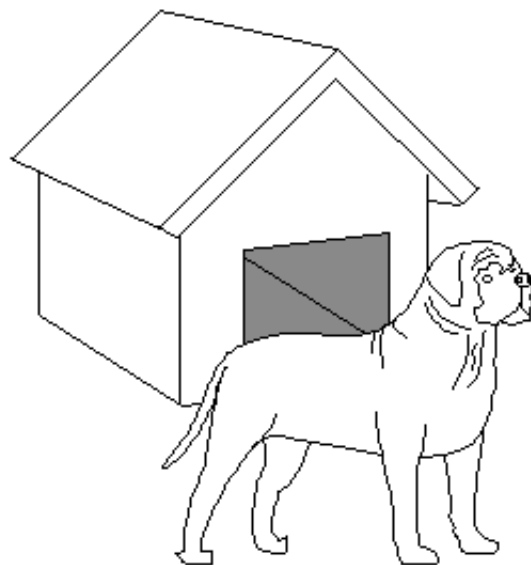
The dog is next to the doghouse.

behind



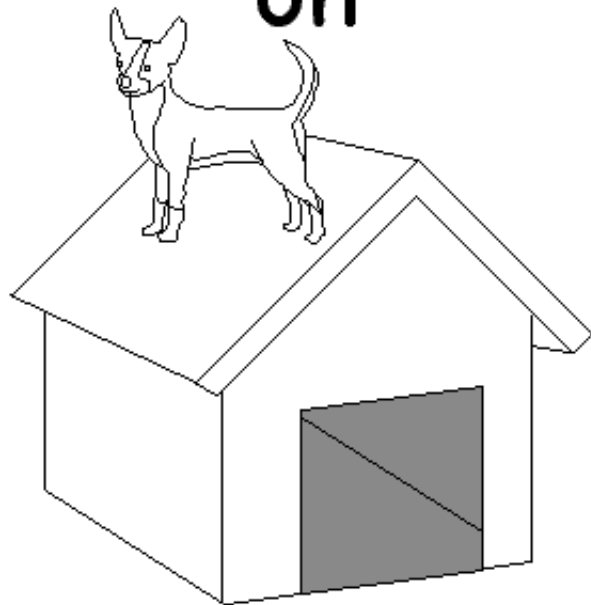
The dog is behind the doghouse.

in front of



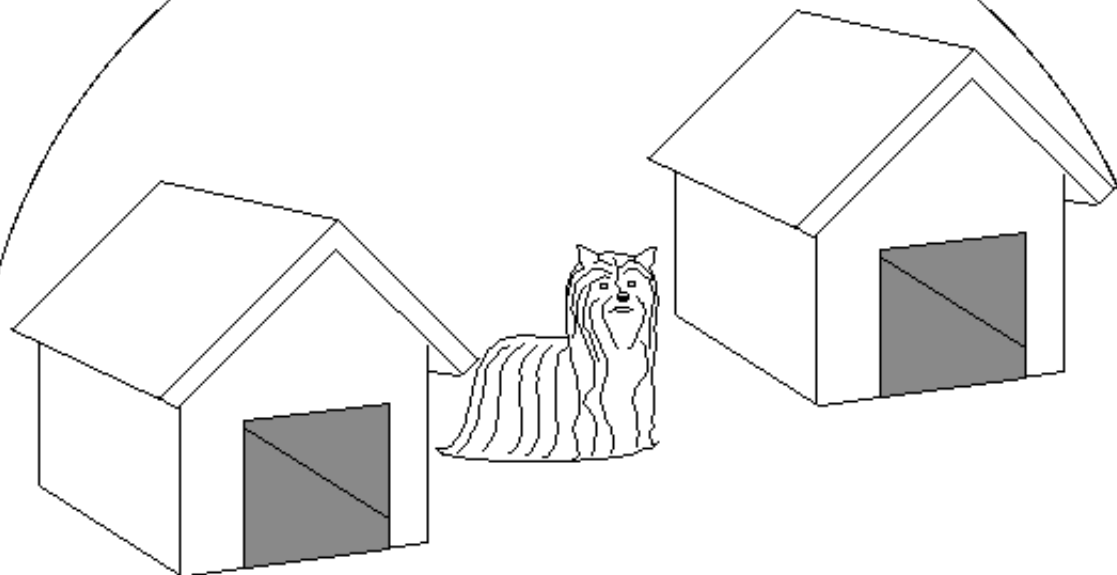
The dog is in front of the doghouse.
