

Classify sentences.

SN = subject noun **V** = verb **Adv** = adverb **Adj** = adjective **P** = prepositions

OP = object of the preposition

Put a parentheses around prepositional phrases. Prepositional phrases begin with the preposition and end with the object of the preposition.

Ex.

Adj Sn V Adv P A Adj Op
Several monkeys chattered loudly (in the large tree).

Adj Adj Sn V P A OP
1. Three young children ran (across the street.)

A Sn V Adv P A OP
2. The fish jumped out (of the tank.)

A Adj Sn V P A Adj OP
3. A beautiful kite soared (in the blue sky.)

A Adj Adj Sn V P A OP
4. The delicate glass bowl fell (down the stairs.)
