

Label parts of speech. Underline the **subject** once and the **verb** twice.
Put the first parentheses in front of the **preposition** and the second parentheses around the **object of the preposition**.

SN= subject noun **V**= verb **P** = preposition **OP** = object of the preposition
A = article

SN V P A OP
Jane sat (under the tree.)
